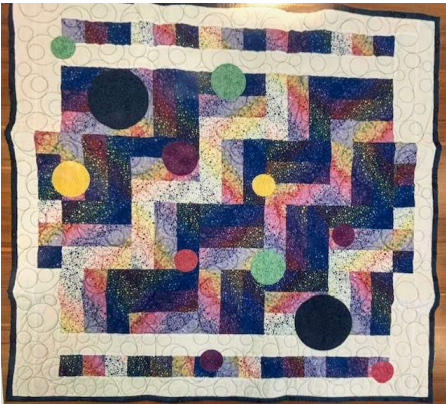

## STASH BUSTER!

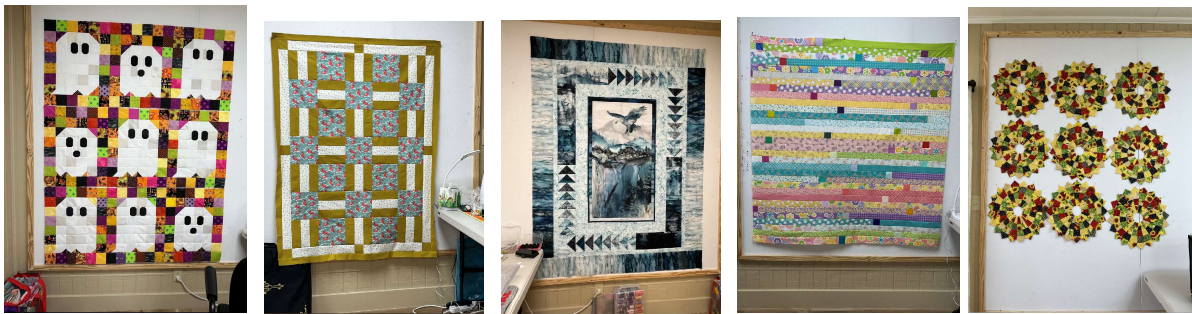

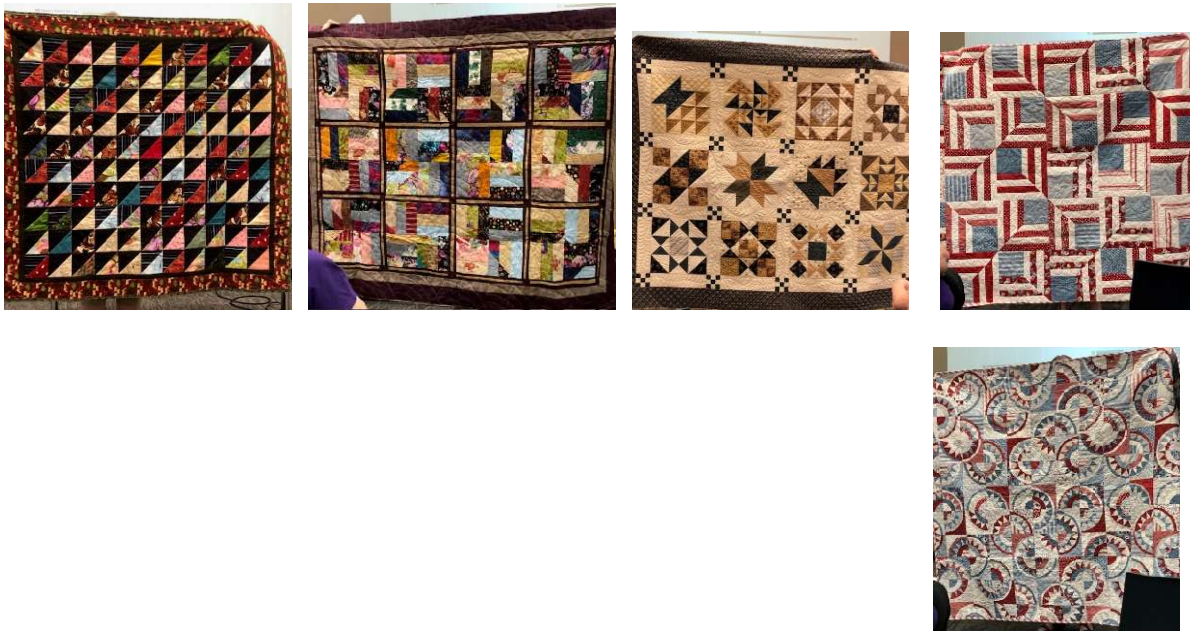

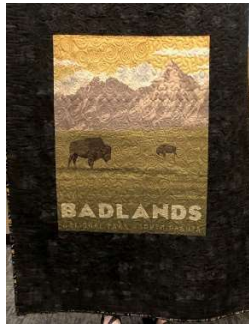
