

CCQG Meeting Minutes
August 14, 2025
Boerne Library Community Room

President Jennifer called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.
She welcomed CCQG member Linda H to present the program.

Program:

- Linda has been a member of CCQG for 15 years and was a new quilter when joined. Her favorite quilting form has become Art Quilts. No artists or quilters in her family growing up in OK. An art teacher in school inspired her with two words - collage & chalk pastels.
- Trained as a medical technologist (good at reading instructions).
- She had no stash but started her first quilt (paper pieced!) in 1995 inspired by a magazine cover and finished 20 years later.
- She recreated pictures or paper collage she saw onto fabric.
- She explained process and displayed many of the following quilts:
- 2006 - collage with little quilting; 2015 - TX flag & Alamo wall hanging; Guatemalan fabric that looked woven; Trip to Greece photos were traced on fusible web with minimal quilting; Dtr-in-law's parents safari photos; 2017 ethereal painting of birds/trees with Stonehenge fabrics & stamps for trees (won 3 blue ribbons); Glenn Gould record jacket graphic design using hand dyed fabrics; Fish made out of all fusibles w/ tiny zig zag edges; Bird on wrought iron gate; Cat from picture with fusibles; Italian Arch painting from a magazine; Cadillac ranch in W TX (challenge); Baghdad quilt will be in SA quilt show Sept 2025; African Embroidery blocks purchased several year ago at Houston.
- Her quilting became more involved year after year. Sometime she had to wait years to find the "right" fabric for each quilt.
- She did ask artist's permission if she was going to enter it into a show.
- She is teaching free motion workshop on Friday. Bring your quilts if you need ideas for quilting.
